A community theatre diva. No personal life with only theatre to give her identity and reinforcement.
- Dot** (female 70s plus) Former professional actor but now she enjoys "playing" in community theatre.
- Judy** (female 40s +) No filter but a good heart. A rough exterior hides a soft interior.
- Brianna** (female late teens) New to theatre. Recently lost her Mom and she is a little lost inside herself.
- Grace** (40s to 60s) The Director, a bit of a perfectionist.
- Narrator** This is a significant role as this person will be describing scenes and actions throughout the play. Vocal tone, clarity and pacing are prime considerations.
